Correct Number Placement

Your Race number needs to be placed on the riders left hand side of your jersey, down the bottom so that the number is visible to the camera, if we cannot see your number you may not get a result.

See below images for example.



Correct Timing Chip Placement

So that we pick up your bike crossing the line correctly, please follow the below instructions for correct placement of your timing chip.

1. If you already have a race result timing chip holder (see further down for cable ties), please insert the timing chip with the red side facing outwards on the left-hand front fork of your bike, secure with the additional rubber band as shown below.



2. If using cable ties to secure timing chip, place your cable ties through the top gap on the timing chip as shown below.



3. Wrap the end of the cable ties around your front left fork, being careful not to wrap around any spokes on your wheel



- 4. Thread the ends of the cable ties back through the bottom gap of the timing chip and then through the other end of the cable tie.
- 5. Pull the cable tie tight so it secures it against the fork, leaving enough gap to be able to remove it later but secure enough so it does not move while riding.



- 6. Cut off the excess length of the cable ties.
- 7. During Roll-out commissaires will check this is secured correctly and that the timing chip is detecting.
- 8. Good luck in today's event and remember to return both your numbers and timing chips to the Canteen after all your events have been completed.
